- Follow up on past events
 - Sherman STEAM Open House
 - Discussed there are a lot of events all at once
 - The event was well attended, STEAM Open House is the open house that is part of the District Calendar, this timing is driven by the district
 - Fun way to see the whole school
 - Is there an opportunity to get Student Voice back on the event?
- October Roundtable \$1,300
 - It was during conference week which was a conflict for Teachers who wanted to participate

 - Would like to do more trainings and childcare (currently offering childcare at PTSA Meetings to reduce barriers to accessing meetings)
- Yearbook Committee
 - Request for additional funding of \$1500 total cost is \$3000
 - Group discussed reimbursement
 - If yearbooks are sold at \$10 a piece and 300 are sold would recoup the funds
 - Each student gets a disposal photo then will develop them, scan them and put them in the yearbook
 - 85 students are participating
 - For future years: Can there be other camera options? (Camp Snap?) Holds 2,000 photos per card, \$60 a piece
 - **VOTE**: Motion to approve reimbursement of Parent Volunteer for up to 3,000. Attendee seconded. Minutes were approved unanimously.
